- Manage and instruct Secondary extra-curricular activities including theater competition
- Coordinate and manage co-curricular events including theatrical competitions and concerts
- Work closely with department chairperson and teachers to determine instructional goals, objectives and methods for student achievement
- Create a classroom environment conducive to learning and appropriate for spiritual, physical and social development of students
- Manage the annual budget of the theater program.
- Support and promote the mission and core beliefs of BCS
- Other duties as assigned

- Must have a valid teacher certification or ability to obtain within one year of hire
- Must have 3+ years of experience in theater or drama in an educational environment. Master's degree in theater or performing arts may substitute for experience.
