HEAD GIRLS BASKETBALL COACH

HEAD BOYS BASKETBALL COACH

Brandon Greene has been the Head Boys Basketball Coach as well as Computer Science and Personal Finance teacher since 2017. He joined BCS after three years of coaching at The Cambridge School of Dallas, two of which he was the Head Boys Varsity coach. Coach Greene led the CSD Lions to one post-season appearance as head coach and was the assistant coach for CSD's 2015 team who won the TAPPS 2A state championship. While in high school at Westbury Christian School, Coach Greene was a member of two TAPPS 4A state championship teams. Coach Greene also won an American Southwest Conference championship while playing at The University of Texas at Dallas.

HEAD GIRLS SOCCER COACH

Nick Marquez holds a USSF "C" License and was a member of the Olympic Development Program in New Mexico, where he was also an All-State midfielder and eight time state club and high school champion. Coach Marquez graduated from the University of Oklahoma with a degree in Mechanical Engineering as a National Hispanic Merit Scholar.

Jesse Jordan has been the Varsity Boys Soccer Coach since 2016. He has led our team to District & Area Championships and a #6 ranking in the state. He also coached the JV & Varsity Soccer teams from 2007 to 2011, leading the Varsity team to the playoffs three years in a row and JV to a tournament championship. Coach Jordan holds a B.A. in Kinesiology from Harding University and has over nine years of coaching experience with organizations such as CoachUp, FSBescola - Austin, CC United Soccer Club, Lifetime Fitness, and Lonestar Soccer Club of Austin. Coach Jordan holds USSF license and was nationally recognized twice in CoachUp's Coach Spotlight Series.

SIGN UPS: October 3 - October 9 available online.

SEASON: Early November until late February (Last day to withdraw for refund is November 4, 2019).

TRYOUTS: All student athletes will be placed on a team corresponding to but not limited to age, grade level, position, as well as their talent and experience level.

5/6 Girls: 10/29-11/01 at 3:45PM-5:15PM
7/8 Girls: 10/29-10/30 at 7:00AM-8:48AM

5/6 Boys: 10/29-11/04 at 5:15PM-6:45PM
7/8 Boys: 11/01-11/05 at 7:00AM-8:48AM

PRACTICES:

5/6: Two practices per week (Monday through Friday afternoon/evening)

7/8: Three practices per week (Before-school morning practices from 7:00AM until the end of 1st period)

Basketball training and conditioning will also take place in regular P.E. classes during the season. Optional skill training sessions available on Saturdays, run by HS coaches and MS coordinators.

GAMES: Typically each team will play one game per week, beginning the week of November 11, 2019. The game schedule will be released November 9, 2019.

TOURNAMENTS: Each team must qualify for the end of season CAPPs tournament. 6A Teams may play one additional tournament during the season.
