Dear BCS Seniors and Parents,

Sunday, May 24 at 5:00pm we will be together for the first time and we are truly rejoicing that we will be together to share in worship and blessings. Please find instructions for the event below. There are contingency plans in place in case of rain and we will enact those plans if necessary. The plans below are in anticipation of a dry Texas spring day.

- Please arrive on campus between 4:30 4:45.
- Upon entering campus you will come to the first checkpoint where you will be asked a series fo COVID symptom related questions. This will also act as your campus entry registration. Only those registered to attend will be allowed in the worship center.
- When you park, please use every other spot and do not park directly next to another vehicle. There will be parking assistance available but please practice distancing in parking.
- When you exit your car please put on your face covering and keep it on for the duration of the ceremony.
- Upon exiting your car you will form two lines through the courtyard. The lines will have markings on the ground designating the necessary distancing and please stay together as a family unit.
- Each line will lead to a table where your temperature will be checked using a laser, non-contact forehead scanner. Please note that anyone with a temperature in excess of 100 degrees will not be allowed to enter the worship center.
- When you enter the worship center you will be given assigned seating.
- Seating is based on the ability of creating a minimum of a 10 foot buffer between each group of people. On the shorter rows your family will have a row to themselves and the longer rows will have three people on each end.
- When you enter the worship center please go to your assigned seating area and please do not congregate in the foyer or aisles. Seniors will sit with your parents.
- Once seated, please know the restrooms will be accessible for emergency purposes only and only one person at a time may use the facilities. The restrooms will be sanitized after each usage.
- During the ceremony the singing will be played over the speaker system and there will not be group singing.
- When the senior's name is called you will go to a designated spot on the stage for your blessing. While on this spot you may remove your mask. There will be no one within 15 feet of you at this time. Please put your face covering back on before exiting the stage.
- At the end of the ceremony there will be a formal dismissal aisle by aisle.
- Please do not congregate in the aisles or fover at the end of the ceremony.
- Once outside, the administrative duties of BCS end but we do ask that you maintain your face covering and social distancing while visiting outside.

We are excited to once again have you on campus. We will glorify God together and you will receive your blessing by your chosen BCS faculty member. We will also be able to share some

exciting news about graduation. The full ceremony will be live streamed and the directions for accessing the live stream will be coming soon.
