- BCS will maximize classroom time. We intend to be open and on campus in the fall. We are being told that the intent from the government is for schools to be open and to avoid mass long-term closings like were seen in the spring of 2020.
- BCS is taking many steps to create as much normalcy as possible on campus while making the school as safe as possible. From hallway traffic flow to plexi-glass barriers in shared spaces to sanitation stations to cohort based groupings BCS has an extensive plan to keep your student safe and healthy while making the day feel as normal as possible. Next year will be different but the differences will be overshadowed by the efforts being put in place to make learning on campus a joyous return. There is a tremendous amount of effort being put into making school days seem as normal as possible while being as safe as possible.
- BCS has multiple educational plans based on the needs of the community.
 These plans include full opening with social distancing, hybrid opening with some students having the option to work online from home and some on campus, online classes should the need arise, and daycare provision for elementary students whose parents have to leave the home to work.
