BCS has invested in AirBox air purifiers for each and every classroom and multi-purpose facility on campus including the cafeteria, gyms, locker rooms, theaters, etc. These are not your home-based air purifiers. AirBox air purifiers are actually air scrubbers that remove 99.999% of SARS-CoV-2 pathogens at the micron level. This is the highest grade air purification possible and puts the air quality of the classrooms on par with a surgical operating room. This was a significant investment for BCS, but the health of our students coupled with the ability for them to learn with as few distractions as possible made the investment worthwhile.

When the school year began, we welcomed over 150 new students to BCS. We also welcomed back to campus nearly 100 Bears who spent the better part of last school year online.
